To secure an appointment for <u>dual citizenship</u>, the complete application should be mailed to and received by the Embassy no later than <u>9 April 2018</u>. Individual confirmation will be made via phone/email upon receipt of the application.

Dual citizenship applicants who also wish to apply for a Philippine passport after their oath taking should indicate their intention in the cover letter sent with their dual citizenship application and comply with the applicable passport application requirements.

It is important that applicants with appointments come with all the required documents to avoid the rejection of their application. Please note that all fees are payable in cash or money order.



All passport and legalization applicants are required to bring their prepaid self-addressed return envelope with tracking number from USPS.



All applications are strictly by appointment only. Appointments will be automatically scheduled as they are received. Requests for specific time slots will not be entertained.
