The Philippine Embassy in Washington D.C., in cooperation with the Filipino Association of the Bahamas and Overseas Filipino Workers International in Bahamas, is pleased to announce that it will be sending representatives to Bahamas on 3 - 5 March 2018 to provide passport, civil registration, dual citizenship, legalization and overseas voter registration services. Interested applicants are required to strictly observe steps outlined below to secure an appointment.

- Scan all requirements as listed on the website <http://philippineembassy-usa.org/philippines-dc/consular-services-dc/> and email to outreach@phembassy-us.org. In the subject, indicate **BAHAMAS OUTREACH**.
- Send payment in money order or cashier’s check payable to the “Philippine Embassy” (Consular Section, Philippine Embassy, 1617 Massachusetts Ave., NW, Washington DC, 20036) by mail, individually or by group*.
- Schedule of fees:
 - Passport (First time and Renewal) \$ 60.00
 - Lost Passport \$150.00
 - Legalization \$ 25.00/doc
 - Civil registration \$ 25.00/doc
 - Dual Citizenship \$ 50.00 principal / \$ 25.00 derivatives
- Include brief cover letter indicating:
 - Name/s of Applicant/s
 - Contact Email and Number
 - Type of Service (i.e, passport, civil registration, legalization, dual citizenship, overseas voter registration)
 - Outreach Site: Bahamas
 - Amount Sent:

- Wait for Embassy email confirmation with date and time of appointment.

- Come to the outreach site 20 minutes prior to the approved appointment schedule with original documents.

- Wait for the approved application:
 - ☛ Passport: 6-8 weeks from application
 - ☛ Civil Registration: Spot Release
 - ☛ Legalization: Spot Release
 - ☛ Dual citizenship: Spot Release

PASSPORT FINDER

Check the passport finder <http://philippineembassy-usa.org/finder/searchpassport.php> to determine availability of passport for release.

If available, send old passport for cancellation, together with prepaid return mailing envelope (Any carrier of choice except FedEx).

Applicants may send individually or as a group.
